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DOH Corner

Happy New Year! As you are aware, MY3 of QIP-NJ concluded on December 31, 2023. DOH wants to congratulate all of our hospital partners on completing another year of the program, which DOH hopes will show continued progress in terms of quality improvement and achievement of individual performance targets.

MY4 of QIP-NJ is now officially underway! MY4 began on January 1, 2024 and will run through the end of the year. DOH is pleased to announce that on December 22, 2023, we received one-year approval from the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for MY4 of QIP-NJ.

Important: MY 2 Results

QIP-NJ has completed the review of Non-Claims Based appeals. Results will be combined with MMIS results and MY 3 targets in a forthcoming notice later this month or early February. Separately, QIP-NJ will send letters to hospitals notifying them of the expected MY 2 payments that that each Medicaid Managed Care Organization will be authorized to make to hospitals within 2024 Q1.

MY 4 LOI Submission

MY 4 LOI materials were distributed in December and required all NJ acute care hospitals to affirmatively respond indicating whether they intend to participate in MY 4 of QIP-NJ. In addition, the LOI process included a Medicaid ID/billing provider NPI validation section and DOH has worked with DHS on this front to ensure appropriate IDs are captured for purposes of QIP-NJ. Responses from hospitals were due **December 22, 2023.** DOH has reviewed all LOI submissions for MY4 and will be sending out confirming letters shortly.

MY 4 Preprint

DOH, in partnership with PCG and DHS, received one-year approval from the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for MY4 of QIP-NJ on December 22, 2023.

Quality Measures Committee (QMC) #10 Meeting

Following the tenth QMC meeting for QIP-NJ, DOH invited QMC members to review codes adjustment for consideration in MY 4. Results were reviewed and disseminated earlier this month to QMC members with a high degree of concurrence among members. DOH sincerely appreciates QMC members for their time and attention in supporting QIP-NJ measurement policies.

Forthcoming Program Measurement Policies and Documents

QIP-NJ is currently finalizing version 3.1 of the MY 3 Databook, Standard Reporting Template (SRT) and SRT Guide, and Value Set Compendium which will be necessary for MY 3 reporting later this year. QIP-NJ is also developing in tandem MY 4 draft versions of these documents for hospitals review. Both sets of documents will be posted to the QIP-NJ website in early February and an announcement will be sent to QIP-NJ program leads informing them of their availability.

Other State Initiatives and Programs

- Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (ALSO) training is an evidence-based training used by birthing providers and interprofessional maternity care teams to handle obstetric emergencies. NJ DOH encourages teams to look into the components of the training. You can find more information on the training program here.
- The Nurture NJ Strategic Plan, which aims to make NJ the safest and most equitable place in the national to deliver and raise a baby. Please check the <u>Nurture NJ website</u> for more information and to discover new ways to become engaged.
- The NJ Maternal Care Quality Collaborative (NJMCQC) aims to achieve a significant and sustained improvement in overall maternal and infant morbidity and mortality rates statewide. The final public meeting for this year was held in December 2023. DHS' Episode of Care (EOC) Pilot is a three-year pilot to test a new alternative payment model for prenatal, labor, and postpartum services statewide. More information regarding the EOC Pilot can be found on DHS' website at the link below. Performance Period 1 (15 months) of the EOC Pilot ran from April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. Performance Period 2 (12 months) began on July 1, 2023 and will run through June 30, 2024. Performance Period 3 (12 months) will run from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.
