QIP-NJ officially goes live on July 1, 2021! DOH would like to thank all hospitals for submitting their QIP-NJ Measurement Year 1 (MY1) LOI. For those who indicated they will be participating, DOH looks forward to working with your teams on improving care for the behavioral health (BH) and maternal health populations in New Jersey.

DOH would also like to thank hospitals for their engagement in the various QIP-NJ webinars, forums, and meetings. DOH appreciates all hospitals' thoughtful questions and insights to support the QIP-NJ team in developing and updating QIP-NJ materials.

QIP-NJ MY1 LOI Update

The QIP-NJ LOIs, confirming or declining participation in QIP-NJ for MY1. were due from all NJ acute care hospitals on June 15, 2021. Thank you to all hospitals for submitting a completed LOI.

We look forward to working with all hospitals participating in QIP-NJ! As a reminder, hospitals may participate in MY2, even if they did not participate in MY1. If the hospital elects to participate in QIP-NJ in a subsequent MY, the hospital must provide: (1) the necessary baseline data to determine performance targets and payment calculations and (2) a completed LOI confirming participation and agreeing to program conditions. The hospital also agrees that if it elects to participate in subsequent MYs, it will be required to close 50% of the performance gap from the prior MY in addition to the full gap of the MY in which the hospital joins as a participant.

QIP-NJ FAQ v1.0 Document: Now Available!

DOH is excited to share that the QIP-NJ FAQ document is now available on the QIP-NJ Documents & Resources webpage. The QIP-NJ FAQ document provides additional guidance and clarification to key partners and stakeholders relative to QIP-NJ, and covers topics including but not limited to general information, eligibility and participation, attribution, measure selections and updates, measurement and payment calculations, hospital funding and payments, Learning Collaboratives, and program support. As DOH receives additional questions, this document will be updated as indicated by the version number and date in the header. Any new and/or revised questions or language from the prior version of the FAQs will be denoted with bold and underlined text, e.g., "Sample". Databook, VSC, and Databook FAQ v1.1: Available on July 1, 2021

Thank you to all hospitals that submitted questions and feedback on Databook and VSC v1.0 via the QIP-NJ inbox, webinars, and technical contact forums. We are currently incorporating these changes and will post the Databook and VSC v1.1 by July 1, 2021 to the QIP-NJ <u>Documents & Resources</u> webpage. A change log will also be published to show and describe all changes made from Databook and VSC v1.0 to v1.1.

We are also excited to share that the Databook FAQ will be available on July 1, 2021 on the QIP-NJ <u>Documents & Resources</u> webpage. The Databook FAQ is a comprehensive guidance document that addresses the most common and foundational QIP-NJ Databook questions that concern general performance measurement and specific measures. Baseline Attribution List Update

In prior communications, DOH had indicated that QIP-NJ would share baseline (MY0) attribution lists with all participating hospitals prior to the program start date of July 1, 2021. However, after running preliminary baseline attribution lists, DOH identified a small number of hospitals that had various data anomalies that required further research and targeted conversations to address.

As part of our validation and quality assurance process, as well as to ensure the accuracy and completeness of baseline (MY0) attribution lists, DOH is working with the small number of hospitals with data anomalies to immediately remediate these findings. After solving these issues, DOH will be running final attribution lists for the baseline (MY0) period and will provide that information to participating hospitals no later than the end of July 2021. DOH would like to reiterate that this shift in the timeline for sharing the baseline attribution lists will not substantively impact program start and any associated hospital due dates will be shifted and communicated via normal distribution channels.

Additionally, DOH is having internal discussions to create a process for participating hospitals to submit their Medicaid IDs/Billing Provider National Provider Identifiers (NPIs) for DOH and Department of Human Services (DHS) approval prior to MY1 attribution calculations.

QIP-NJ SFTP Access

Thank you again to all of those that have returned their hospital's LOI and completed out the QIP-NJ Contact Information and Access Request form. Those who have identified themselves as their hospital's primary contact on the LOI and those who have requested access via the Access Request form will be given access to the QIP-NJ SFTP. Credentials will be sent via QIP-NJ@pcgus.com and a QIP-NJ SFTP User Guide is available on the QIP-NJ Participants & Stakeholders webpage. Please note, to ensure security, three users per hospital will be granted access, with an additional two users for health systems. Any additional access requests will be granted on a case-by-case basis.
